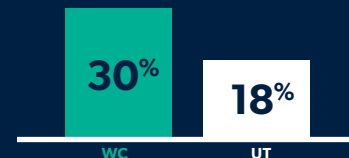

Washington County **reduced its per capita water use by 30%** compared to the state's average of 18%.²
